GENERAL INFORMATION

ARRIVING BY CAR

COMING FROM THE A5:

Coming from the north, follow directions at the „Heidelberg Intersection“ to „Heidelberg“. You will automatically join the „Bergheimer Straße“. At the second large set of traffic lights turn right into „Mittermaierstraße“ and continue straight on. After approx. 700 meters you will see the Main Station to your right and the Print Media Academy to your left.

Coming from the south take the exit „Heidelberg/Schwetzingen“. From the motorway slip road you will join the „Speyerer Straße“ in the direction of Heidelberg. Continue straight on this road. Cross 5 traffic light junctions and then drive under an underpass crossing 2 further junctions at which point you will automatically drive onto the „Montpellier Bridge“.

WARNING: THERE IS A SPEED CAMERA HERE!

At the 8th junction turn left into the „Lessingstraße“ in the direction of Hauptbahnhof/Chirurgie“. This street takes you directly to the „Mittermaierstraße“ at which point you can already see both towers of the Print Media Academy to your right.

ARRIVING BY TRAIN

The Print Media Academy lies directly opposite Heidelberg’s main station and therefore just 2 minutes by foot from the station. Please refer to the Deutsche Bahn form in order to find the most effective rail connection.

PARKING

CARPARK „P20“ BG CHEMIE | KARL-METZ-STRASSE 15

The carpark is just a few minutes by foot from the Print Media Academy. Coming from the A5 take the „Bergheimer Straße“. At the 2nd large set of lights turn right into „Mittermaierstraße“ and continue straight on. At the second set of lights turn right into the „Kurfürsten-Anlage“. After just a few meters turn right into the „Karl-Metz Straße“. The carpark is to your right.

The parking charge for 7 hours is Euro 6.10. Each additional hour is charged at Euro 0.60. The carpark is open until 21.00hrs!

CARPARK „P15“ KLINIKUM BERGHEIM | THIBAUTSTRASSE 1A

The carpark is approx. 15 minutes by foot from the Print Media Academy. Coming from the A5 you will automatically join the „Bergheimer Straße“, continuing on this road for approx. 3km. On reaching the Bergheimer Apotheke (to your right and opposite a flower shop to your left) cross the tram tracks and turn left into the „Thibautstraße“. The carpark is to your right. Take the main exit (Hauptausgang) in order to get back to the „Bergheimer Straße“.

Until 19.00hrs parking charges are Euro 1.50 for the first two hours and then Euro 1.00 for each additional hour. From 19.00hrs onwards the first two hours are charged again at Euro 1.50 and each additional hour Euro 1.00. The carpark is open until 02.00hrs!
